2026 CLICKRukiga, UGANDA MONITORING VISIT

A group of seven Committee Members and supporters have just returned from a very successful and fulfilling visit with our friends in Rukiga.

On Sunday, we went to St James Buhangizi Church the Sermon was received enthusiastically by our Rector Christine, sharing the pulpit with Canon Stephen as translator. This was followed by our wonderful reception with almost fifty of our sponsored children and young people to whom we presented new shoes and Crosses.

The week continued at pace with lots of visits to individual children and families' homes where interviews were recorded to capture our young people's hopes for the future.

This was followed by visits to the Kamwezi Primary school where progress was noted in relation to a new modern boys' latrine, and to Kamwezi High School where we were pleased to see the completion of a girls' dormitory.

Next on the agenda was our inspection of the new Rukiga Youth in Development (RYID) Centre which impressed our group with its build quality and potential. We were entertained by the trainees' singing, dancing welcome and extremely gratified to be part of a tree planting ceremony to celebrate the tenth anniversary of RYID.

The visit was completed with an enjoyable day at the Hope Clinic and the Kisiizi Hospital, including the famous water falls, by most of the group.

Meanwhile, I visited my old colleague Sister Sophie Kentwiga in the town of Mbarara. We worked together in Bushenyi Teacher Training College from 2003 to 2005. Sophie is still a working Nun at the age of 82, training the Novices entering the Convent.

This is a brief summary of our visit. We look forward to sharing more details in future editions of the ICN.

THE POWER OF THE TONGUE

During this season of Lent, many of us take time to reflect on our lives and on the state of the world around us. It is difficult not to feel concerned, when we see conflicts and wars across the globe – situations that sometimes make us fear where humanity might be heading.

At times I find myself wondering what is being discussed in the boardrooms and places of power where such decisions are made. What words are being spoken that could lead nations towards such destructive paths?

This question reminds me of the words found in Epistle of James 3:5, where we are told that although the tongue is a very small part of the body, it can make great boasts and cause great harm. Like a small spark that can start a large fire, our words carry enormous power.

Too often we forget how much influence our words have. With our tongues we can either build people up or tear them down. This thought led me to pray for our world leaders – that they may use their words wisely and make responsible decisions for the good of all.

But reflection must also begin closer to home. I realised how easy it is for discouraging words to stay with us far longer than kind ones. Even when many good things are said, it is often the negative comment that lingers in our minds.

This led me to pray that God would help me to use my own words more carefully - to ensure that my tongue brings encouragement rather than harm.


Some people seem naturally gifted at this. They greet others warmly, notice something positive, or offer a simple word of appreciation. In their presence, people flourish. As Hilary Brand writes in 'Finding a Voice', encouragement has the power to help others blossom.

During this Lent, I have set myself a simple task: to use my words to encourage the people around me. If we all learn to use our tongues wisely - in our homes, workplaces, churches, and communities - our world may become a kinder and better place for everyone.

May the Lord bless and keep you well.

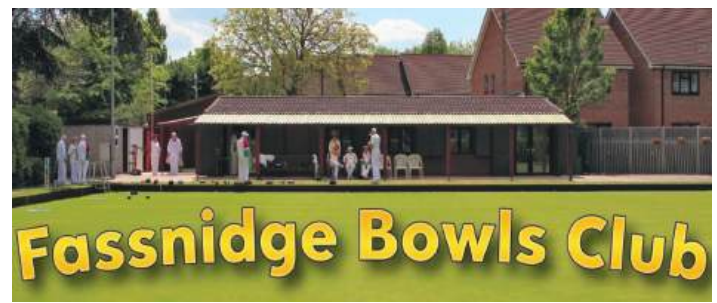
